ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY TO FILE FOR REVIEW SPECIFIC TIME-OF-DAY TARIFFS FOR CUSTOMERS WITH DEMANDS GREATER THAN 1,000 KW PURSUANT TO ORDERING PARAGRAPH 2.a OF DECISION NO. 86543

Ordering Paragraph 2.a of Decision No. 86543 issued October 26, 1976 provides:

"2.a. Within one year after March 16, 1976, PG&E, SDG&E, Edison, California-Pacific Utilities Company, Pacific Power and Light Company, and Sierra Pacific Power Company, respondent electric utilities, shall install additional metering for customers with demands greater than 1000 KW to permit the use of the time-of-day schedules with respect to such customers and 60 days thereafter shall file specific time-of-day tariffs for review."

By letter dated May 9, 1977, Southern California Edison Company (Edison), respondent, has requested that it be granted an extension of time to comply with that portion of Ordering Paragraph 2.a of Decision No. 86543 requiring the filing of specific TOD tariff schedules for customers with demands greater than 1,000 kw from May 15, 1977 until thirty days after a decision has been rendered by the Commission in Application No. 56408.

In support of such request for extension of time Edison states:

- "1. Such Ordering Paragraph 2.a will impact Edison's customers served on Tariff Schedule No. A-7.
- "2. However, many of the provisions of the anticipated TOD tariff filing for Edison's Schedule No. A-7 customers will depend upon the Commission's decision in Edison's Application No. 56408. Such application related to a review of specific TOD tariffs for Edison's large usage (Schedule No. A-8) customers having a demand of 5000 KW or more and was filed by Edison on April 16, 1976. Hearings in that matter were completed on November 5, 1976, and it has been pending for decision by the Commission since the briefing schedule was completed on January 10, 1977.
- "3. Since the TOD rate design criteria for Edison's Schedule No. A-7 customers are expected to be in many respects similar to those adopted in the TOD tariffs for Edison's Schedule No. A-8 customers, it is desirable that Edison have the benefit of the Commission's views in its decision in such Application No. 56408, before Edison files specific TOD tariffs for its Schedule No. A-7 customers."

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the time within which Southern California Edison Company shall file specific time-of-day tariffs for review pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 2.a of Decision

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No. 86543, issued October 26, 1976, is extended from May 15, 1977 until thirty days after a decision has been issued by this Commission in Application No. 56408 of Southern California Edison Company.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
