SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision 87061, dated March 9, 1977, the City of Stockton was authorized to construct March Lane at grade and to close the existing Fulton Street Crossing, both across the tracks of The Western Pacific Railroad Company in the City of Stockton, San Joaquin County.

The Western Pacific Railroad Company, by its letter of April 26, 1977, advises that further review of the legal description of the right-of-way which it has granted to the city indicates that the original calculation placing the location of the proposed March Lane Crossing at Milepost 96.9 was in error. The railroad further advises that the correct location of the proposed March Lane Crossing is at Milepost 97.06.

IT IS ORDERED that Finding 1 of Decision 87061 shall be modified to change the identification of the proposed crossing of March Lane at grade across the tracks of The Western Pacific Rail-road Company in the City of Stockton, San Joaquin County, from Crossing 4-96.9 to Crossing 4-97.1.
