ORDER GRANTING REHEARING

The complaint of Samuel and Dory Urcis (Urcis) seeks an order of the Commission requiring California-American Water Company to provide service to their lot in the City of Carmel-By-The-Sea. Ex parte Decision No. 87022, dated March 1, 1977, granted in part the relief sought by the Urcis. However, the Urcis are still without water service.

On April 21, 1977, the Urcis filed a document entitled, "Second Amendment to Complaint - Request for Further Ex Parte Relief," which the Commission will treat as an application for rehearing of Decision No. 87022. The Commission has considered each and every allegation of the application for rehearing and is of the opinion that good cause for rehearing has been demonstrated. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Rehearing of Decision No. 87022 is granted;
2. Hearing shall be held before such Commissioner or Administrative Law Judge and at such time and place as may hereafter be designated;
3. The Executive Director is directed to cause notices of hearing to be mailed at least ten (10) days before such hearing.
