SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

It has come to the Commission's attention that Appendix A, page 3, Special Condition 2, of Decision No. 87399 dated June 1, 1977 is in error. Special Condition 2 states that there is a monthly charge of \$500; the monthly charge should have been \$625.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Special Condition 2 on page 3 of Appendix A of Decision No. 87399 shall read:

- 2. A monthly charge of \$625, one-twelfth of the initial charge per year, will be due and payable on the first day of each month. Charges for deliveries in excess of the 100 acre-feet during the yearly period will be monthly.
