ORDER RESCINDING DECISION 85647

By Decision 85647, dated March 30, 1976, in Application 55928, James Mayweathers, Jr. and George Grisham, a partnership, were granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between the Communities of Inyokern, Ridgecrest and Trona and intermediate points.

In Ordering Paragraphs 2(a) and (b) the applicants were required to meet the insurance requirements of the Commission's General Order 101-C and the filing of tariffs and timetables in the Commission's office, respectively, that were due on or before July 28, 1976. The Commission has not received a Certificate of Insurance or the tariff and timetable filings.

It appears and the Commission finds that there is good cause for rescinding Decision 85647.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision 85647 is rescinded.
