ORDER RESCINDING DECISION 86460

By Decision 86460, dated October 5, 1976, in Application 56076, Peter Myers, Patricia Hale and Dorothy Keech, dba San Jose Tours Co. (PSC-1006), were granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between the City of San Jose, on the one hand, and certain points in the Counties of Santa Clara and Santa Cruz, on the other hand.

In Ordering Paragraphs 2(a) and (b) of Decision 86460, the applicants were required to meet the insurance requirements of the Commission's General Order 101-C through the filing of a Certificate of Insurance with this Commission and the filing of tariffs and timetables in the Commission's office, respectively. These documents were not received by the Commission.

It appears and the Commission finds that there is good cause for rescinding Decision 86460.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision 86460 is rescinded.
