ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision 61836 dated April 12, 1961, in Application 42608, as amended by Decision 62693, dated October 17, 1961, in Application 43533, Southland Harbor Cruises, Inc. was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a vessel common carrier between points in the Long Beach - Los Angeles Harbor.

Since April 13, 1975, Southland Harbor Cruises, Inc. has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order 1113.

The Commission staff sent a certified letter dated April 14, 1977 to the carrier's last known address as shown on the Commission's records alleging the carrier was not exercising its authority and advising that the staff would recommend to the Commission that the carrier's certificate be revoked unless the staff received a reply to its allegation before April 24, 1977. The registered letter was returned on May 1, 1977 stamped "UNCLAL ED."

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforenamed certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ONDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a vessel common carrier authorized by Decisions 61836 and 62693, in Applications 42608 and 43538, respectively, is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Southland Harbor Cruises, Inc. are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Executive Director shall mail a certified copy of this order to Southland Harbor Cruises, Inc. at 2850 Josie Avenue, Long Beach, CA 90815, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
