ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 85424 dated February 3, 1976, applicant J. S. Shafer, Jr., was authorized, pending public hearing, to deviate from the minimum rates for transportation services provided for Griffith Company. That authority was due to expire June 30, 1976 but was extended to December 31, 1976 by Decision No. 86030 dated June 29, 1976 and further extended to June 30, 1977 by Decision No. 86792 dated December 21, 1976. Hearings were held June 1 and 2, 1977 in Los Angeles, and the matter was submitted on briefs to be filed July 1, 1977.

Final determination cannot be accomplished before the current authority expires. It is appropriate therefore to extend the present authority to September 30, 1977.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The authority granted by Decision No. 85424 shall expire on September 30, 1977 unless sooner canceled, modified, or extended by order of the Commission.

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2. In all other respects Decision No. 85424 shall remain in full force and effect.
