O P I N I O N

Ronald C. Kelsey, an individual doing business as Sierra Lines, operates as a passenger stage corporation (PSC-142) for transportation of "home-to-work" passengers between Concord, Orinda, Lafayette, Pleasant Hill, Walnut Creek, Danville, Alamo, Berkeley, El Cerrito, Oakland, Hayward, San Leandro and Fremont, on the one hand, and the Lawrence Radiation Laboratory in Livermore, on the other hand.

By this application, Ronald C. Kelsey seeks authority from the Commission to establish alternate routes to operate between Oakland and Lawrence Radiation Laboratory in Livermore.

The applicant alleges that the alternate routes would reduce mileage of the existing Route "O" and would benefit passengers by reduction in traveling time.

The applicant indicates that additional patronage could be developed as a result of the service along the proposed routes.

Notice of the filing of this application appeared in the Commission's Daily Calendar of February 18, 1977. No protests have been received.

The Commission's Transportation Division staff has reviewed the application and recommends that it be granted.

After consideration, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require the alternate routes as proposed by the applicant. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the project involved in this proceeding may have a significant effect on the environment.

A public hearing is not necessary.

The application should be granted and Appendix A of Decision 66779 should be revised accordingly.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ronald C. Kelsey, doing business as Sierra Lines, is authorized to extend his present operations as a Passenger Stage Corporation as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, between the points and over the routes set forth in Appendix A of Decision 66779, as amended herein.
2. Appendix A of Decision 66779 in Application 46029 is amended by incorporating therein First Revised Page 5 in revision of Original Page 5, which page is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
3. In providing service pursuant to the authority granted by this order, applicant shall comply with the following service regulations. Failure so to do may result in a cancellation of the authority.
  - (a) Within thirty days after the effective date of this order, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate granted. Applicant is placed on notice that if he accepts the certificate he will be required, among other things, to comply with the safety rules administered by the California Highway Patrol, the rules and other regulations of the Commission's General Order 98-Series, and the insurance requirements of the Commission's General Order 101-Series.
  - (b) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date of this order, applicant shall establish the authorized service and file tariffs and timetables, in triplicate, in the Commission's office.

- (c) The tariff and timetable filings shall be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff and timetable filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the authorized service.
- (d) The tariff and timetable filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filings of tariffs and timetables set forth in the Commission's General Orders 79-Series and 98-Series.
- (e) Applicant shall maintain his accounting records on a calendar-year basis in conformance with the applicable Uniform System of Accounts or Chart of Accounts as prescribed or adopted by this Commission and shall file with the Commission, on or before March 31 of each year, an annual report of his operations in such form, content, and number of copies as the Commission, from time to time, shall prescribe.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

Alternate Routes: (Continued)

2. Commencing at the intersection of San Ramon Valley Boulevard and Sycamore Valley Road in Danville, thence over Sycamore Valley Road to Interstate Highway 680; return by reverse of route.
- \*3. Commencing at the intersection of Broadway and 40th Street in Oakland, thence along Broadway, MacArthur Blvd., Harrison Street, 20th Street, Webster Street, 14th Street, First Avenue, and E. 14th Street to the intersection of E. 14th Street and 35th Avenue in Oakland.
- \*4. Commencing at the intersection of E. 14th Street and 35th Avenue in Oakland, thence along E. 14th Street, First Avenue, 14th Street, Harrison Street, Oakland Avenue, MacArthur Blvd. and Broadway to the intersection of Broadway and 40th Street in Oakland.
