ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By Decision No. 85985 dated Jume 2, 1976 Chichester Transportation Co., Inc. was granted interim authority, pending hearing, to deviate from the minimum rates governing the transportation of cans, can ends, canned goods, tin plates, and pallets from and to various northern California points. The interim authority, which was initially scheduled to expire with January 1, 1977, was extended to July 1, 1977 by Decision No. 86635, issued November 16, 1976 in this proceeding.

Due to extenuating circumstances, applicant was unable to sustain its required burden proof at the public hearing of Application

No. 56498 held on March 3, 1977 before Examiner Gagnon at San Francisco. Accordingly, the matter was continued to a date to be set.

Upon applicant's written request after hearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 56498 is dismissed and Decision No. 86635 is rescinded.
