ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 85254 dated December 16, 1975, as amended by Decision No. 85651, dated March 30, 1976, and by Decision No. 87155, dated March 29, 1977, applicant J. S. Shafer, Jr. was authorized, pending public hearing, to deviate from the minimum rates for transportation services provided for Corona Rock and All American Asphalt. That authority will expire June 30, 1977.

A hearing was held in this matter on June 1, 1977 in Los Angeles, and the matter was submitted on that date. Final determination cannot be accomplished before the current authority expires. It is appropriate, therefore, to extend the present authority to July 31, 1977.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The authority granted by Decision No. 85254, as amended by Decision No. 85651 and Decision No. 87155, shall expire on July 31, 1977, unless sooner cancelled, modified, or extended by order of the Commission.

2. In all other respects, Decision Nos. 85254, 85651 and 87155 shall remain in full force and effect.
