OPINION

Island Enterprises Inc., a California corporation, presently provides service as a vessel common carrier (VCC-37) to transport passengers and their baggage in shoreboats between certain points on and along Santa Catalina Island.

By this application, Island Enterprises Inc., seeks authority to increase its passenger fares by 50 percent to 66 2/3 percent.

The applicant alleges that the requested fare increases would cover the substantial increase in fuel, maintenance, insurance and labor expenses incurred since the present fares were established.

Its present fares were established by Decision 84685, dated July 22, 1975, in Application 55493.

The staff of the Transportation Division has made an analysis of applicant's operations and submitted a report on the estimated results of operations, based on the rate year ending December 31, 1977 under present and proposed fares. The report is hereby received as Exhibit No. 1. The exhibit indicates the following results:

Notice of filing of this application appeared in the Commission's Daily Calendar on April 27, 1977. No protests have been received.

After consideration, the Commission finds that:

- 1. The shoreboat service at Catalina Island is primarily summer seasonal business.
- 2. The requested increase would result in additional annual revenue in the amount of \$41,600.
 - 3. The proposed fare increase is justified.
- 4. A public hearing is unnecessary.

 The Commission concludes that the application should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- l. Island Enterprises, Inc. is authorized to establish the increased rates proposed in Application 57256. Tariff publications authorized to be made as a result of this order may be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public.
- 2. The authority shall expire unless exercised within ninety days after the effective date of this order.
- 3. In addition to the required posting and filing of tariffs, applicant shall give notice to the public by posting in its vessels and terminals a printed explanation of its rates. Such notice shall be posted not less than five days before the effective date of the rate changes and shall remain posted for a period of not less than thirty days.
