SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision 87537, dated June 28, 1977, D and F Trucking Co., Inc., was granted authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (MRT 2) in connection with the transportation of commodities requiring frozen temperature control service for Wagner Distribution Services, Inc. and Packers Cold Storage Inc. By Decision 86432, dated September 28, 1976, Kenneth Cooley, doing business as Cool Transportation, was granted authority to deviate from MRT 2 in connection with the transportation of the same commodities for Packers Cold Storage, Inc.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the authority granted to Kenneth Cooley should be extended to expire concurrently with the authority granted to D and F Trucking Co., Inc. so that future renewals of such authorities may be considered at the same time. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the effective date of this order should be the date hereof because there is no reason to delay the action proposed herein.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ordering paragraph 2 of Decision 86432 is hereby amended by substituting therefor the following:

"The authority granted herein shall expire with June 28, 1978, unless sooner cancelled, modified or extended by further order of the Commission."
