OPINION AND ORDER

The above complaint was heard before Administrative Law Judge Daly at San Francisco on June 27, 1977, pursuant to the Commission's Expedited Complaint Procedure wherein findings, conclusions, and the need for a court reporter were waived by all parties.

Complainants contend that they should not have been charged \$89 for the installation of telephone sets, which they personally transferred from their old office to their new office, and should have been afforded the benefit of defendant's in-place connection charges, which are lower.

Paragraphs 2.a, 2.b, and 2.d of defendant's Schedule Cal. P.U.C. 28-T, 1st Revised Sheet 27, provide that in-place connection charges apply only if the equipment is used in place, with no change in color, type, or location of facilities. In this instance there was a change in location of facilities.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the relief requested is denied.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
