ORDER EXTENDING TIME

On July 1, 1977, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) filed for an extension of time to comply with Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 86081. Ordering Paragraph 1 requires respondent electric utilities to file tariff schedules incorporating the electric priority list of customers and uses attached to Decision No. 86081 as Appendix A.

On January 18, 1977 in Decision No. 86875 the time for filing was extended for six months to July 18, 1977 to allow for completion of hearings on implementation of the electrical curtailment

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plan. These hearings have not been concluded, and it is apparent that no decision will be forthcoming until after July 18, 1977.

IT IS ORDERED that the date for filing tariff schedules in compliance with Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 86081 is extended until further order of the Commission.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
