ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By D.84619 (1975) and D.86032 (1976) applicant was granted interim authority to increase passenger fares on the steamship Catalina between San Pedro and Avalon amounting to 70 percent of the rate increases sought, pending determination of final rate relief after public hearing.

On or about February 16, 1977 the steamship Catalina was sold at public auction by a United States marshall to a private party to satisfy debts. The vessel is not available to applicant for operation in common carrier service for the 1977 summer season. Since the steamship no longer is in applicant's possession or control, the application should be dismissed and the interim authority heretofore granted pursuant to it should be revoked. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 55721 is dismissed and the authority heretofore granted by Decisions Nos. 84619 and 86032 is revoked.
