OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (MRT 2) names minimum rates and rules for the statewide transportation of general commodities by highway carriers. By this petition, California Trucking Association (CTA) seeks to have MRT 2 amended by establishing therein a reduced truckload commodity rating for the transportation of shipments of drugs or medicines in straight shipments and in mixed shipments with candy or confectionery, deodorants, toilet preparations, dental plate adhesive powder or cleaning compounds, mouthwash, shaving cream or soap, cough drops or tablets, adhesives in metal collapsible tubes, electrical appliances or instruments (hot lather machines), certain plastic articles, and safety razors or blades.

Petitioner states that straight shipments of similar commodities are in themselves less costly to handle than mixed shipments of different commodities, and the power loading and unloading of straight shipments without carrier involvement, as proposed, further promote and reflect savings that carriers may realize in transporting such shipments. Petitioner avers the Commission has, by its Decision No. 79952, recognized the sound.

transportation economies involved in sharing the savings experienced by joint efforts of shippers and carriers. Petitioner submits that its proposal demonstrates such economies.

Copies of the petition and the amendment thereto were mailed to various chambers of commerce, shipper organizations, and carrier representatives. The petition and amendment were listed on the Commission's Daily Calendars of December 16, 1976 and April 29, 1977, respectively. No objection or protests have been filed.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that petitioner's proposal is reasonable and the resulting rates and charges will be just, reasonable, and nondiscriminatory minimum rates and charges for the transportation involved. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the petition should be granted as set forth in the ensuing order and the effective date of this order should be the date hereof because there is an immediate need for this rate relief.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 2 (Appendix D to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective August 10, 1977, the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A, also attached hereto, which pages and appendix are by this reference made a part hereof.
2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject to Decision No. 31606, as amended, are hereby authorized to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein.
3. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than August 10, 1977, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rating authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 461.5 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rating published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

5. In all other respects Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
