ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision 83831, dated December 17, 1974, in Application 54413, Four Winds Transportation, Inc., was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation for "home-to-work" service between certain points in Orange and Los Angeles Counties, on the one hand, and certain plants at El Segundo, Los Angeles Airport facilities and Anaheim, on the other hand.

On April 7, 1977, the Commission staff sent a letter to the carrier stating that its authority would be revoked for failure to perform its authorized transportation service. The carrier was advised to respond before April 22, 1977 or the Commission staff would recommend to the Commission that the carrier's authority be revoked. The Commission staff has not received a reply to its letter.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation, authorized by Decision 83831 in Application 54413, is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Four Winds Transportation, Inc., are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Executive Director shall mail a certified copy of this order to Four Winds Transportation, Inc., at 126 East Dyer Road, Santa Ana, CA 92707, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
