AMENDED ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision 85254 dated December 16, 1975, as amended by Decision 85651, dated March 30, 1976, and by Decision 87155, dated March 29, 1977, applicant J. S. Shafer, Jr. was authorized, pending public hearing, to deviate from the minimum rates for transportation services provided for Corona Rock and All American Asphalt. Pending hearing the authority was extended to July 31, 1977 per Decision 87542. On July 12, 1977, per Decision 87594, the sought authority was granted.

On July 21, 1977, applicant filed for rehearing of Decision 87594 dated July 12, 1977.

Under the terms of Section 1733 of the Public Utilities Code, the effective date of the order is stayed until the application is granted or denied.

It is appropriate, therefore, to extend the present authority to November 30, 1977.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The authority granted by Decision 85254, as amended by Decisions 85651, 87155 and 87542 shall expire on November 30, 1977, unless sooner cancelled, modified, or extended by order of the Commission.
