ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR
COMPLIANCE WITH DECISION NO. 87507

On April 15, 1975, in Case No. 9902, the Commission instituted an investigation into the operations and service of all public utility water corporations under its jurisdiction for the purpose of determining revisions to the Uniform Main Extension Rule necessitated by the modifications to General Order No. 103 ordered by Decision No. 84334. The Order Instituting Investigation in Case No. 9902 was amended on June 28, 1977 to include consideration of whether facilities contributed to water utilities should be held in trust for the public and surrendered to a public agency upon condemnation without compensation.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR, the Commission hereby extends the time for the receipt of comments referred to in Decision No. 87507 until November 22, 1977.

The Executive Director is directed to cause certified copies of this order and Decision No. 87507 to be served forthwith on all respondents and interested parties served with the Order Instituting Investigation in Case No. 9902.
