AMENDED ORDER SETTING HEARING

By Order Setting Hearing dated June 7, 1977, the Commission ordered that hearings be held in the captioned proceeding for the receipt of evidence relative to the establishment of commodity rates for the transportation of glass containers in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 on an interim basis.

The Commission's staff has announced that its full scale cost and rate studies for the aforementioned commodity will be completed by September 1977. The staff has requested that the proceeding not be limited to the establishment of commodity rates for the transportation of glass containers on an interim basis, but be expanded for receipt of evidence for the establishment of permanent rates for said commodity. The proceeding will be broadened, as requested.

IT IS ORDERED that a public hearing for the purpose indicated be held in this proceeding before an Administrative Law Judge at a time and place to be determined.
