ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision 74417, dated July 16, 1968, in Application 50156, as amended by Decision 81572 and Resolution PE-151, George Frasca was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a Passenger Stage Corporation between the San Fernando Valley area of the City of Los Angeles and Malibu Pier or Zuma Beach in the County of Los Angeles, serving the termini and intermediate points along the routes described in Appendix A of the above authorities during the summer season of each year.

On June 7, 1977, the Commission staff sent a registered letter to the carrier, alloging that the carrier was not exercising its authority. The Commission staff warned the carrier that its authority would be revoked should it fail to reply by June 17, 1977. The registered letter was returned to the Commission staff on June 13, 1977, marked, "NOT DELIVERABLE AS ADDRESSED, UNABLE TO FORWARD".

Since October 9, 1974, George Frasca has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damages for personal injury or property damages, as required by General Order No. 101-C.

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The carrier has not filed an Annual Report for 1974 and thereafter.

It appears, and the Commission finds, that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforenamed certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation authorized by Decisions 74417 and S1572 in Applications 50156 and 54028, respectively, and Resolution PE-151 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of George Frasca are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Executive Director shall mail a certified copy of this order to George Frasca, at P. O. Box 4993, Panorama City, CA 91412, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.
