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SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision 43813, dated February 14, 1950 in Case 4808, Charles E. Bull, operating as a passenger stage corporation between Redding and Redding Municipal Airport, was exempted from the established minimum rates when transporting express shipments weighing not more than 100 pounds between the aforesaid points. It has come to the Commission's attention, in a letter from Robert W. Dugger, dba Airport Bus Service, dated November 8, 1976, that he was authorized by Commission Decision 85457 in Application 55972, dated February 18, 1976 to purchase the operative right of Charles E. Bull. Through inadvertence, the exemption authorized Charles E. Bull was not simultaneously transferred to Robert W. Dugger.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that this matter should be corrected by the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision 43813 in Case 4808, be and it is hereby amended by substituting Robert W. Dugger, doing business as Airport Bus Service to the list of carriers contained in paragraph (c) of Finding No. 14 of Decision 31606 thereof for Charles E. Bull.

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This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
