ORDER EXTENDING SUSPENSION

On June 7, 1977, the Commission entered Decision No. 10346, which suspended until September 15, 1977, the operation and effectiveness of the tariffs filed by General Telephone Company of California under Advice Letter No. 4041 and supplements.

On July 26, 1977, the presiding Administrative Law Judge sought to calendar the matter for August 1977. The Commission staff and counsel for protestant Western Independent Directory Publishers Association indicated that they were not ready to proceed at that time. In the circumstances, the suspension should be continued pending hearing and adjudication of this matter.

IT IS ORDERED that the operation and effectiveness of the tariffs filed by General Telephone Company of California under Advice Letter No. 4041 and supplements, heretofore suspended until
