SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 87284 dated May 3, 1977 ordered T. & T. Trucking, Inc. (T. & T.) to pay a punitive fine of \$1,500 and an under-charge fine of \$10,425.51, both fines being due on or before July 5, 1977. On May 16, T. & T. requested permission to pay the fines in monthly installments of \$500 because of financial difficulties that would occur to the company, such as selling equipment, if the fine were to be paid on July 5. On August 22 T. & T. offered to pay \$750 a month.

The staff has made a thorough review and analysis of T. & T.'s financial condition and concurs in the request to provide monthly payments of \$750 commencing October 1, 1977.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 87284 is modified to provide that the manner of payment of the fines set forth in that decision be \$750 commencing October 1, 1977 and \$750 on the first day of each month thereafter until the fine, plus interest

as required by Decision No. 87284, is fully paid. Should T. & T. Trucking, Inc. fail to make a payment when due, the entire fine shall become due and payable.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
