ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company seeks authority, pursuant to General Order 36-D, to abandon its Class D nonagency station at Oliveto in Sonoma County.

By Decision No. 87752, dated August 23, 1977, the Commission repealed General Order 36-D and adopted General Order 36-E. General Order 36-E applies only to station facilities for passenger service. Commission authority is, therefore, no longer required to effect the sought relief.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 57449 is dismissed.

This order is issued pursuant to Section 308 of the Public Utilities Code and Resolution No. A-4638.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
