OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Data Transportation Co., Inc. requests authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariffs 2, 4-B and 19 in connection with transportation of copying, reproduction, telecommunication and computer machines and their components or related parts, accessories, materials or supplies for Xerox Corporation.

The proposed transportation would be conducted in areas as follows: 1) Between various points in certain designated San Francisco and Peninsula zones, portions of the East Bay and the San Jose Metropolitan Area zones, and all the zones in the Los Angeles Area Metropolitan Zone Group; 2) Between the aforesaid zones and various points in California; and 3) Between various points in California outside of the aforesaid zones.¹

The application is based on special circumstances and conditions detailed therein.

¹ The applicant seeks to provide services within Metropolitan Zones 102 through 107, 116 through 135, and 201 through 262, as described in the Commission's Distance Table 8.

Revenue and expense data submitted by applicant indicate that the transportation involved may reasonably be expected to be profitable under the proposed rates.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of July 11, 1977. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant's proposal is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. Applicant is placed on notice that should its operations for Xerox Corporation be between fixed termini or over a regular route, it should apply for a highway contract carrier permit. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted as set forth in the ensuing order and the effective date of this order should be the date hereof because there is an immediate need for this rate relief.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Data Transportation Co., Inc. is authorized to perform the transportation shown in Appendix A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof at not less than the rates set forth therein.

2. The authority granted herein shall expire one year after the effective date of this order unless sooner cancelled, modified or extended by further order of the Commission.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.

Data Transportation Co., Inc. is authorized to transport shipments of copying, reproduction, telecommunication and computer machines and their components or related parts, accessories, materials or supplies, when moving in connection therewith for Xerox Corporation between points, as listed below, and subject to the rates and conditions as set forth:

APPLICATION OF

RATES:

See Schedule 1 - Rates for transportation conducted:

- a) Within or between Metropolitan Zones 102 through 107 and 116 through 135.

OR

- b) Within or between Metropolitan Zones 201 through 262.

See Schedule 2 - Rates for transportation conducted:

- a) Between a point in Metropolitan Zones 102 through 107, or Zones 116 through 135, or Zones 201 through 262 and a point outside the aforesaid zones.

OR

- b) Between various points in the State outside the aforesaid zones.

See Schedule 3 - Charges for Accessorial or Additional Services.

CONDITIONS: 1. Rates herein apply for service performed during regular working hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., except Saturdays, Sundays, and the following holidays: New Year's Day, Washington's Birth-day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day; and December 24th and December 26th, where so observed as holidays, under labor agreements. When such holidays fall on Sunday, the following Monday shall be considered a holiday. Except as otherwise provided, for services performed at the request of the shipper or consignee at other than those hours and on Saturdays, Sundays or the holidays shown, additional charges for overtime will be assessed as indicated herein.

2. Shipments will be received and transported under the Straight Bill of Lading - Short Form - Freight Bill provided by Xerox Corporation.
3. Shipments transported under the terms and conditions herein are released to a value not exceeding fifty cents (\$0.50) per pound, per article.
4. References to Metropolitan Zones (MZ's) are those zones as described in the Commission's Distance Table No. 8 and subsequent revisions or reissues thereto.
5. Applicant has not indicated that subhaulers will be used nor have any costs of subhaulers been submitted. Therefore, if subhaulers are employed, they shall be paid no less than the rates authorized herein without any deduction for use of applicant's trailing equipment.
