ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Applicant has filed to request that the temporary certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 86385 dated September 14, 1976 in Application No. 56474 be extended for one year or until the Commission renders a decision in Application No. 57475, filed with the Commission on July 26, 1977, whichever event occurs first. The temporary certificate grants authority to fly between Eureka and Redding, and applicant has been transporting passengers between these two points since the certificate was issued.

Application No. 57475 requests that applicant's authority be extended to permit transportation of passengers between all points served by applicant to include Redding and Eureka.

We will extend the temporary certificate for one year.

IT IS ORDERED that the temporary certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 86385 in Application No. 56474 is extended to September 15, 1978.
