## OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent (WMTB), seeks authority, on behalf of Pacific Motor Transport Co. and Pacific Motor Trucking Co. (collectively referred to as PMT) to publish charges for service performed between the hours of 5:15 P.M. and 8:15 A.M. Monday through Friday.

Applicant states that PMT maintains regular hours of service between 8:15 A.M. and 5:15 P.M. Monday through Friday; however, shippers may request service at other than regular working hours. PMT is willing to perform this service provided it is compensated for the additional expenses incurred.

Applicant asserts that increases resulting from the proposal herein would not increase its California intrastate gross revenue by as much as one percent. Applicant anticipates that the yearly revenue increase under its proposal should approximate \$1,100.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of August 1, 1977. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

The proposed charges are set forth in Item 50, Paragraph (E) of WMTB Local, Joint and Proportional Freight and Express Tariff No. 111, Cal. P. U. C. No. 15.

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In the circumstances, the Commission finds that increases resulting from applicant's proposal are justified. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, is hereby authorized, on behalf of Pacific Motor Transport Co. and Pacific Motor Trucking Co., to publish an amendment in its Local, Joint and Proportional Freight and Express Tariff No. 111, Cal. P.U.C. No. 15, as specifically proposed in the application.
- 2. Tariff publications authorized to be made as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public.
- 3. The authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within ninety days after the effective date of this order. The order shall become effective twenty days after the
