## ORDER DENYING REHEARING OF DECISION NO. 86542

On August 8, 1977, County Water Company of Riverside filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 87621. After reviewing each and every allegation presented in the petition, the Commission is of the opinion that good cause for rehearing has not been shown to exist. However, the Commission finds that certain statements of fact contained in Decision No. 87621 should be made to conform to the record.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Rehearing of Decision No. 87621 is hereby denied.

2. Lines 15 through 21 of page 6 of Decision No. 87621 are modified to read:

". . . There is less reason to certificate this particular project than others of comparable small size because in this instance the entire development is surrounded by or near municipal water districts, one of which has agreed to supply water to the project. We would expect if we were to certificate this project, eventually it would be absorbed into the district responsible for the water supply."
