ORDER EXTENDING EXPIRATION DATE

Applicant holds authority to assess less than the otherwise applicable minimum rates pursuant to Decision No. 86527 dated October 19, 1976. The authority is scheduled to expire October 19, 1977.

On September 16, 1977 applicant filed a request seeking a 90-day extension of the expiration date. The request alleges that recently the Commission has changed its requirements with respect to Section 3666 applications, and it is impossible to gather the necessary data prior to the expiration date of the existing authority.

Under the circumstances the Commission concludes that the request should be granted subject to the requirements set forth in the ensuing order. Since it is unlikely the Commission can process the renewal application within 90 days, the extension granted herein will be for a period of six months after the effective date of this order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The expiration date set forth in Decision No. 86527 is extended to six months after the effective date of this order.

2. Application for renewal of the authority set forth in Decision No. 86527 shall be filed within sixty days after the effective date of this order.

3. Applicant shall be prepared to proceed to hearing, if necessary, with the filing of the renewal application.

4. In the event the application for renewal is not filed within sixty days as required by paragraph 2 of this order, the authority set forth in Decision No. 86527 shall be revoked.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
