OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau, Agent (PSFB), seeks authority on behalf of Southern Pacific Transportation Company (S.P.) to cancel Item 1015-I, Supplement 85 of PSFB Tariff 294-F which provides rates on Freight All Kinds and ramp to ramp service for shipper owned or leased trailers and containers between San Francisco, Oakland, San Jose and Roseville on the one hand and Los Angeles on the other.

Applicant states that the rates were established for the specific purpose of securing traffic of Dart Trucking Company, Garden State Paper and Akron Stores; however, the specific business for which the charges were published has not been realized.

Applicant avers that the increases resulting from the proposal herein would not increase S.P.'s revenue by as much as one percent. Applicant anticipates that the yearly revenue increase under its proposal would not exceed \$600.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of September 19, 1977. No objection to the granting of the applicant has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that increases resulting from applicant's proposal are justified. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- l. Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau, Agent, is hereby authorized, on behalf of Southern Pacific Transportation Company to cancel rates as specifically proposed in Application 57570.
- 2. Tariff Publications authorized to be made as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public.
- 3. The authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within ninety days after the effective date of this order.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
