ORDER REINSTATING AUTHORITY AND EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 86463 dated October 5, 1976 applicant was granted interim authority to deviate from minimum rates in connection with certain transportation for Amfac Drug Supply Co. That decision ordered that a hearing be scheduled for receipt of evidence in support of permanent authority. That hearing was scheduled for October 27, 1977 but at the request of applicant was taken off calendar because applicant was not prepared to proceed. Applicant now requests that the interim authority, which expired on October 5, 1977, be reinstated and that the hearing required be scheduled again in the near future to allow applicant to complete the development of its presentation.

We find applicant's requests to be reasonable and conclude that they should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The authority granted in Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 86463 is reinstated.

2. The authority granted herein shall expire six months after the effective date of this order unless sooner canceled, modified, or extended by further order of the Commission.

3. A public hearing shall be scheduled on this application at a date to be set.
