SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

On July 12, 1977, the Commission issued Decision No. 87587 in Application No. 57196, granting Southern California Gas Company a rate increase to track the cost of purchased gas from its suppliers. Inadvertently Rate Schedule G-45 was included on page 2 of Appendix A with the Priority 3, 4 and 5 customers and was assigned a commodity rate of 18.95 cents per therm. This rate is 1 cent per therm higher than the commodity rate assigned to Priority 1 and 2 customers as shown on page 1 of Appendix A.

It has since been determined that all of the utility's G-45 customers are classified as either Priority 1 or 2 and thus subject to the lower rate level.

We find that Appendix A of Decision No. 87587 should be revised to reflect the correct rate level for Schedule G-45.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix A of Decision No. 87587 be revised as follows:
  - (a) All reference to Gas Engine and Schedule G-45 be deleted from page 2 of Appendix A, and

(b) Page 1 of Appendix A be amended to add the following:

Gas Engine Natural Gas Service (Rate Schedule G-45)

Commodity Charge:

All Usage, per therm 17.95¢

Minimum Charge:

Per Meter Per Month \$ 7.00

Cumulative Annual Minimum Charge \$84.00

2. In all other respects Decision No. 87587 remains in full force and effect.
