ORDER GRANTING REHEARING OF DECISIONS NOS.  
87735, 87736 AND 87737 AND DENYING REHEARING OF  
DECISIONS NOS. 87048, 87049, 87050 AND 87051

On September 27, 1977, by Decision No. 87922 we granted rehearing of Decision No. 87734, the second interim order in these combined proceedings. We did so in response to a petition for rehearing filed by the California Manufacturers Association.

On September 28, 1977 Traffic Managers Conference of California (TMC) filed a petition for rehearing and reconsideration or reopening of the same Decision No. 87734 as well as the three supplemental orders which were issued concurrently for purposes of tariff distribution. Those are Decisions Nos. 87735, 87736 and 87734.

On October 20, 1977 California Trucking Association (CTA) filed a petition for rehearing of the above-mentioned four decisions and also of Decisions Nos. 87048, 87049, 87050 and 87051, the first interim opinion in these proceedings and the supplemental orders issued therewith. Those decisions were issued and effective on March 9, 1977, and have long been final.

We have carefully considered the petitions of TMC and CTA and the allegations contained therein and are of the opinion that good cause for rehearing of Decisions Nos. 87048, 87049, 87050 and 87051 has not been shown. However, in granting rehearing of Decision No. 87734 it is appropriate to grant rehearing of the supplemental orders also. Any modification to Decision No. 87734 which might ensue as a result of this rehearing would necessarily affect the supplemental orders. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that rehearing of Decisions Nos. 87735, 87736 and 87737 is hereby granted, said rehearing to be consolidated with the rehearing of Decision No. 87734 previously granted by Decision No. 87922 and already set for hearing at 10 a.m. on November 7, 1977, in the Commission Courtroom, San Francisco. Rates in effect pursuant to Decisions Nos. 87735, 87736 and 87737 shall remain in effect until further order of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that rehearing of Decisions Nos. 87048, 87049, 87050 and 87051 is hereby denied.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
