SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision 88088 dated November 8, 1977 in this proceeding granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity as a highway common carrier of general commodities to Unlimited Service Pick-Up and Delivery, Inc. The certificate applies to operations within an area of Central California of a 150 mile radius of Sacramento. It has been brought to the attention of the Commission's staff that a portion of a certain route was inadvertently omitted from Appendix A of that decision.


In the circumstances, it appears that the necessary correction should be made by the order herein and that Appendix A of Decision 88088 should be amended accordingly. The effective date of this order should be the date on which it is signed since there is no known opposition and no known reason to delay correcting the discrepancy.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision 88088 is amended by substituting the attached First Revised Page 1 of Appendix A in place and instead of Original Page 1.

Unlimited Service Pick-Up and Delivery, Inc. by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to conduct operations as a highway common carrier as defined in Section 213 of the Public Utilities Code for the transportation of general commodities as follows:

- A. Between all intermediate points and all points and places on or within five statute miles of the following highways:
1. State Highway 70 between Sacramento and Marysville, inclusive.
  2. Interstate Highway 80, State Highway 65 and State Highway 70 between Sacramento and Marysville, inclusive.
  3. Interstate Highway 80 from Sacramento to Auburn, inclusive.
  4. State Highway 99 between Sacramento and Yuba City, inclusive.
  5. Interstate Highway 80 between Sacramento and Fairfield, inclusive.
  6. Interstate Highway 5 between Sacramento and Woodland, inclusive.
  7. State Highway 99 between Sacramento and Turlock, inclusive.
  - \*8. Interstate Highway 5 between Sacramento and Stockton, inclusive. Serving the off-route point of Tracy.

Except that pursuant to the authority herein granted carrier shall not transport any shipments of:

1. Used household goods, personal effects and office, store and institution furniture, fixtures and equipment not packed in salesmen's hand sample cases, suitcases, overnight or boston bags, brief cases, hat
