ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision 83269, dated August 6, 1974, in Application 54962, Wylie Bedwell Cantrell and Gary Lee Cantrell, doing business as Cantrell Brothers Urban Service, was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between Oxnard and Semtech Corporation, at 652 Mitchell Road, Newbury Park, California.

On August 23, 1977, the Commission staff received a letter from the carrier stating that it would discontinue service effective October 1, 1977.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation of the aforementioned certificate would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation authorized by Decision 83269 in Application 54962 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Wylie Bedwell Cantrell and Gary Lee Cantrell, doing business as Cantrell Brothers Urban Service, are cancelled upon the effective date of this order.
