ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This complaint involves the service of Falcon Charter
Service (Falcon) in connection with its Foster City - San Francisco
commute operations.

Pursuant to Decision No. 87762 dated August 23, 1977 in
Application No. 56923, Falcon was authorized to transfer its Foster
City - San Francisco passenger stage corporation certificate to

C.10131 dz

Mission Trails Charter Service, Inc. (Mission Trails). Mission Trails began operation of the commute service on September 1, 1977.

Case No. 10131 and Application No. 56923, in which Falcon sought increases in its commute fares, were heard on a consolidated record. At the hearing held October 21, 1977, evidence was introduced showing that the transfer of Falcon's Foster City - San Francisco commuter operations had been completed. Complainants then requested that their complaint be dismissed without prejudice as the issues had become moot. Defendant and the Commission staff concur in that request. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the complaint in Case No. 10131 is dismissed without prejudice.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
