ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The complaint alleges certain damages to the complainants resulting from flight cancellations and delays.

The day after the complaint was filed, defendant mailed a check to complainants in the amount of \$177.70 in settlement of the matter.

On August 10, 1977, the Administrative Law Judge assigned to this proceeding wrote to the complainants stating that since the

complaint had apparently now been settled, it would be dismissed unless the complainants notified the Commission within ten days that any further action on the part of the Commission was necessary. No response was received.

We find that this complaint should now be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that Case No. 10354 is dismissed.
