In the matter of the application of GUTHMILLER TRUCKING, INC., a California corporation, for authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff Number 2 in connection with the transportation of glass beverage bottles equipped with plastishield devices, for the account of ROYAL BEVERAGE COMPANY, Oakland, California, pursuant to the provisions of Section 3666 of the California Public Utilities Code.

ORDER OF DISMISSAL AND REVOCATION

By Decision No. 86562 dated October 26, 1976 applicant was granted interim authority to depart from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 for the transportation of glass beverage bottles equipped with plastishield devices from Owens Illinois plants and facilities at Tracy to Royal Beverage Company at Oakland. The authority was scheduled to expire October 26, 1977. By Decision No. 87992 dated October 12, 1977 the expiration date was extended to April 12, 1978.

Public hearing for the receipt of evidence relative to the final disposition of the application was scheduled for December 13, 1977.

By letter dated November 10, 1977 applicant requested that Application No. 56374 be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Application No. 56374 is dismissed.
2. The authority set forth in Decision No. 86562 and extended by Decision No. 87992 is revoked.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
