OPINION AND ORDER

By this application Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, (WMTB) seeks authority, for and on behalf of Eckdahl Warehouse Co. (ECKD), to correct a conflict in its tariff WMTB 111, in regard to exclusive use of the carrier's equipment.

By Decision 87916, dated September 27, 1977, WMTB was given authority to publish tariff provisions allowing ECKD to become party to Item 298 of WMTB Tariff No. 111. These provisions are rules and regulations on full utilization of a unit of carrier's equipment.

In Application 57299, granted by Decision 87916, WMTB overlooked asking for authority to cancel ECKD's participation in Item 395 on exclusive use of carrier's equipment.

Applicant states in order to correct this error authority is requested to cancel ECKD's participation in Item 395.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of August 31, 1977. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant's proposal is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, is hereby authorized, on behalf of Eckdahl Warehouse Co., to publish amendments in its Local, Joint and Proportional Freight and Express Tariff No. 111, Cal. P.U.C. No. 15, as specifically proposed in the application.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

3. The authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within ninety days after the effective date of this order.

The order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
