ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision 86727 dated December 7, 1976, John M. Brainerd, doing business as Flo-Del Co.¹ was authorized to deviate from the minimum rates in connection with the transportation of packages and parcels weighing 100 pounds or less between points within a radius of 100 miles of San Francisco. That authority will expire December 31, 1977.

Final determination cannot be accomplished before the current authority expires. It is appropriate, therefore, to extend the present authority to June 1, 1978.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The authority granted by Decision 86727 shall expire on June 1, 1978, unless sooner canceled, modified, or extended by order of the Commission.
2. In all other respects Decision 86727 shall remain in full force and effect.
