ORDER MODIFYING DECISION NO. 87990

By Decision No. 87990 dated October 12, 1977 in the instant application the expiration date of authority to assess less than the otherwise applicable minimum rates set forth in Decision No. 86527 was extended to April 12, 1978, subject to conditions set forth in Ordering Paragraphs 2, 3, and 4 as follows:

2. Application for renewal of the authority set forth in Decision No. 86527 shall be filed within sixty days after the effective date of this order.
3. Applicant shall be prepared to proceed to hearing, if necessary, with the filing of the renewal application.
4. In the event the application for renewal is not filed within sixty days as required by paragraph 2 of this order, the authority set forth in Decision No. 86527 shall be revoked.

By letter dated December 5, 1977 counsel for applicant requested an extension of time to December 23, 1977 to file its renewal application since the application will not be completely prepared by December 12, 1977.

IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraphs 2 and 4 of Decision No. 87990 are modified as follows:

2. Application for renewal of the authority set forth in Decision No. 86527 shall be filed on or before December 23, 1977.

4. In the event the application for renewal is not filed as required by paragraph 2 of this order, the authority set forth in Decision No. 86527 shall be revoked without further order of the Commission.
