Application of the City of San Gabriel, California, for an order authorizing lowering of the main line of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company and the construction of Ramona Street, Mission Drive, Del Mar Avenue, and San Gabriel Boulevard at separated grades, in the City of San Gabriel, Los Angeles County.

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision 87032, dated March 1, 1977, the City of San Gabriel received authorization for a project to lower the main line tracks of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company and to construct Ramona Street, Mission Drive, Del Mar Avenue, and San Gabriel Boulevard at separated grades, in the City of San Gabriel, Los Angeles County.

To facilitate construction, the City of San Gabriel, by Petition for Modification dated April 29, 1977, requested modification of Decision 87032 regarding protection to be provided at temporary detour crossings.

The Southern Pacific Transportation Company, by letter of November 16, 1977, advised that the application for modification is satisfactory.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision 87032 be modified as follows:  
Ordering Paragraph 2 which reads:

"2. Construction of the temporary detour crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 (General Order No. 72-B), and the temporary detour crossings shall be protected by relocating the automatic gates at the respective existing crossings."

shall be changed to read:

2. Construction of the temporary crossings including:

- A. Detour crossing on existing main line tracks
- B. Existing street crossing on shoofly tracks
- C. Detour crossing on shoofly tracks shall be

equal or superior to Standard No. 1 (General Order 72-B), and shall be protected by automatic gates.

Suitable plans, approved by City and Southern Pacific Transportation Company, shall be furnished to the Commission prior to construction. All rail mounted construction equipment employed in and during the construction of the shoofly shall utilize flagmen for protection at the street crossings.

In all other respects, Decision 87032 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
