OPINION AND ORDER

By this application Ted Peters Trucking Company, Inc., seeks authority to cancel joint rates with Citizens Warehouse Trucking Company, Inc., and Walter F. Peters, dba Peters Truck Lines.<sup>1</sup>

Applicant states that there have been no shipments moving under these joint rates for more than two years. The joint rates are dead rates and should be eliminated in the interest of tariff simplification.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of October 24, 1977. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

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In the circumstances, the Commission finds that increases resulting from the cancellation of the rates, as proposed, are justified. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ted Peters Trucking Company, Inc., is hereby authorized to cancel joint rates as specifically proposed in Application 57646.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

3. The authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within ninety days after the effective date of this order.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
