O P I N I O N

Complainant, alleging improper disconnect, seeks a refund of an \$11 reconnect charge, payment of \$2 for phone calls made from a booth during the period of disconnect, and \$10 damages for inconvenience. Based on the complaint, defendant has credited complainant's December 5, 1977 bill for \$13 (the \$11 reconnect charge plus \$2 for coin phone calls).

As complainant is not entitled to damages and as defendant has paid to complainant the full amount of reparations, we find that the complaint has been satisfied and should be dismissed.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that the complaint is dismissed.
