ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Applicants seek an extension of time in which to comply with the provisions of Decision No. 87746 which authorized the transfer of equipment, operating rights, and the issuance of common stock. Part of the authority granted in Decision No. 87746 expired on December 21, 1977; the remainder on January 31, 1978. The verified petition indicates that applicants are in the process of effectuating an additional transfer of the rights and will file with the Commission and the Federal Communications Commission applications for appropriate authority. In the circumstances, an extension appears warranted. It also appears that a clerical error occurred in Ordering Paragraph 11 of that order which should be corrected herein.

IT IS ORDERED that:

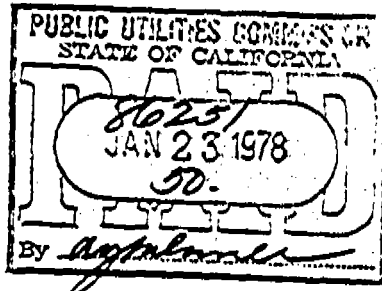
1. The time in which the parties may have to comply with the provisions of Decision No. 87746 is hereby extended until June 30, 1978.

2. Paragraph 11 of Decision No. 87746 is corrected to read as follows:

11. The authority granted by this order to issue stock will become effective when the issuer has paid the fee prescribed by Section 1904.1 of the Public Utilities Code, which fee is \$50. In other respects the effective date of this order is the date hereof.
