ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision 87288, Applicant, Ladytruckers, Ltd., a corporation, was authorized to deviate from the provisions of the minimum rates for the transportation of stage property, sound and lighting equipment and related articles. The authority granted was to expire with May 3, 1978, unless sooner cancelled, modified or extended by further order of the Commission.

The Commission, in a letter received on November 29, 1977, was informed by Mr. A. W. Gardes, Vice President of the corporation, that the carrier has ceased operations and has sold its permit.

In the circumstances, the Commission concludes that the authority granted in Decision 87288 should be revoked.

IT IS ORDERED that:

The authority granted in Decision 87288, in this proceeding, is hereby revoked.

The Executive Director is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Ladytruckers, Ltd., or to mail a certified copy to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

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The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
