OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, seeks authority on behalf of Progressive Transportation Company to amend Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, Local and Proportional Freight Tariff No. 123, Cal. P.U.C. No. 32 by publishing both increases and decreases when transporting commodities requiring the use of low-bed equipment.

Applicant states the objective of the proposal is to eliminate obsolete matter and streamline the tariff to reflect operations as they are currently being conducted. The overall effect of the amendments will result in a reduction in revenue.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of November 8, 1977. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that increases resulting from applicant's proposal are justified. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, is hereby authorized, on behalf of Progressive Transportation Company to publish amendments to its Local and Proportional Freight Tariff No. 123, Cal. P.U.C. No. 32, as specifically proposed in the application.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made as a result of the order herein shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

3. The authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within ninety days after the effective date of this order.

The order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
