The instant complaint proceeding was set for public hearing in Sebastopol on December 13, 1977. At the request of a spokesperson for complainants, the matter was taken off calendar and will be dismissed.

The issue raised by the complaint relates to the need for establishing extended telephone service in Sonoma County. By Decision No. 88232 dated December 13, 1977 in Application No. 55492 and Case No. 10001, The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company was ordered to submit a study within six months of the effective date of the order on

the installation of Optional Calling Measured Service for Sonoma County. The study is to include the necessary information on demand for this type of service over various routes from and to various locations.

IT IS ORDERED that Case No. 10344 is hereby dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
